This Week We Learned...

Literacy: This week we continued work with our Three Little Pigs “expert” books. Each guided reading group is became an expert on one version of the story. They looked at all different aspects of the book such as character traits, handy 5, asking and answering questions about plot, and then compared their book with my Three Little Pigs example book. Next week we will dive into our Unit 3 performance task which includes a fun debate about our books 😊

Math: We looked at different types of number stories this week. We will begin next week with one more type and then move into review with a test on Thursday or Friday.

Spelling: This week’s spelling pattern was –ow and –ew. Next week the focus is –ow and –ea.
