St Math:

I have opened several levels for at home playing. Levels will be opened periodically throughout the year to keep up with district completion requirements. If your child gets on ST Math and there are no levels to complete, then he or she has already completed the levels necessary. I will open new levels up once or twice a month based on class progress.

Literacy: The students have been very busy identifying the parts of a story (Who, What, Where, When, Why and How) This next week we apply the learned skills into performance tasks.

Language: This week's focus was exclamatory and imperative sentences. The students have now learned how to write and punctuate 4 different types of sentences.

Spelling: This week's spelling pattern was digraphs. Next week we will focus on floss words.

2. Twenty minutes of reading and completion of reading/homework log.
